The organizing committee of the Reykjavík International Games, invites you to take part in the RIG 2012.

The city of Reykjavík will for the fifth time welcome sports participants to a multisport competition in Laugardalur, the Valley of Sport, taking place January 19-22.

Athletes compete at a high level in various sports in world class facilities. The venue of the games will be the recently refurbished sports area of Laugardalur which will provide a magnificent setting for the games.

Events will include track and field, swimming, fencing, gymnastics, dance, archery, table tennis, powerlifting, badminton, figure skating, bowling, and judo. In the competition the disabled compete in swimming, table tennis and archery. Some are a part of international circuits and/or give points to world ranking lists. Reykjavik Sports Union and the sports clubs in Reykjavik are the organizers of Reykjavik International Games supported by the city of Reykjavik.

Exciting lectures related to elite sport have become an important part of the schedule of the games along with training camps in some sports. Opening and closing ceremonies among other things will keep the athletes happy and entertained and they will also have the opportunity to visit Reykjavík, the Capital of Iceland, with all its sights and sounds. If lucky you might also see the northern lights.

We anticipate that the Games will draw around 2000 participants including 400 foreigners from over 10 countries and many of them among the best. All further information about participating are to be found on our website: www.rig.is

Important information

Expenses: The organizer covers the expenses of competition, awards and presents. Transfer expenses to and from Reykjavik and accommodation will not be covered by the organizer.

Liability: The organizing committee accepts no responsibility or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury, property loss or damage suffered by the competitors or officials during the competition.

Language: All information will be given in English during the competition.

Music: Music will be played from a CD only. CDs must be handed over to the organizer at the point of registration. The music media must be of good quality and must clearly state the full name of the competitor, program (i.e. long or short), as well as country, name of club and the category in which the skater is entered. All music is returned to the team leader by the end of the competition.

Judges: The participating clubs may propose a judge for the competition. The proposed judge has to be a qualified judge for national championships. If a foreign judge is sent by a foreign competitor, the latter will be responsible of the judge's travel. Names of candidates should be forwarded to the organizer no later than December 1st 2011. Please state name, address/email. The panel of judges will be set soon after the closing of entries. The members concerned will then be notified. The organizer will arrange accommodation and meals for judges during the competition.

Each participating club may propose one ISU recognized Controller and ISU recognized Technical Specialist. In case of too many nominations the first entered will have the priority. The officials nominated will be posted after the closing date of entries.

Meals: It is possible to buy meals, snacks and drinks at the rink throughout the competition

Calculation of results: ISU Judging system all categories.

Awards: The three best placed competitors in each category will be awarded special presents, all others diplomas.

Charges: 85 EUR for 2 programs, 60 EUR for 1 program, is to be paid for each competitor. Payments are to be made in advance, no later than December 1, 2011:

Social events: An opening and closing ceremony will be held for all participating athletes. This is included in the entry fee. Please state number of participants on the entry form.

Dinner will be available on Saturday night, during dinner, dinnerguests will be able to watch competition in dance. Cost approx. EUR 30. Before closing ceremony dinner will be available, cost approx. 20 EUR.
