The organizer will provide Medical Emergency Aid during the competition. In accordance with ISU General Regulations 2010, Rule 119, the organizers may not be held responsible for eventual accidents or other damages to participants, officials or third parties.

8. Music

Music will be reproduced from a CD-player. CD's must be submitted at the time of registration. Each program (short program, free skating) must be recorded on a separate CD. In addition, competitors must have a backup CD ready for each program.

9. Calculation of results

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single Skating 2010, Rule 352, will be in place in all categories.

10. Awards

The three best competitors of each event will be awarded with cups. All other competitors will receive a gift.

11. Opening draw

The opening draw will take place at 09:00 A.M. on **Saturday, October 22nd 2011** at the media centre of the ice rink.
